Organize and access resources using upper storage on panels

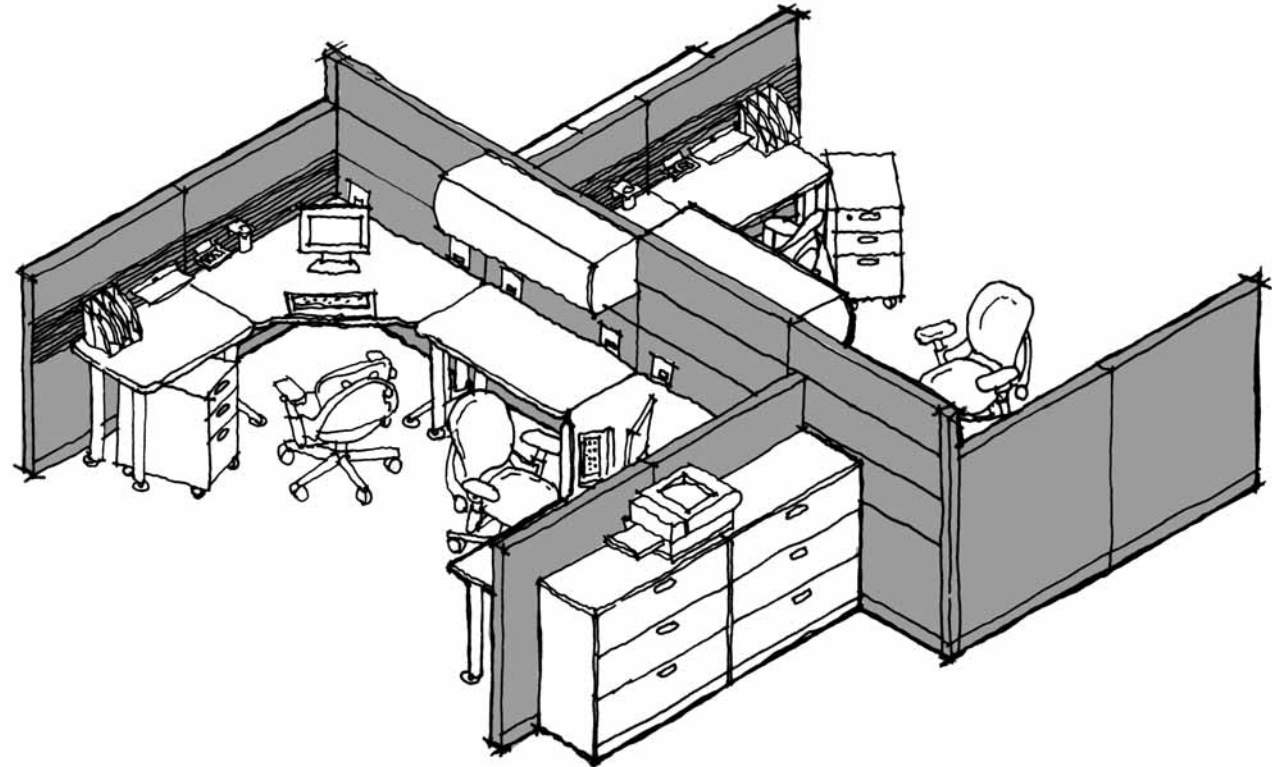
Keep information close at hand yet out of sight with lower storage and lateral files
