America's 5000 Fastest Growing Private Companies Revealed

The 5000 companies that made the list reported aggregate revenue of \$185 billion and median three year growth of 147 percent. Most important, the 2008 Inc. 5000 companies were engines of job growth, having created more than 826,033 jobs since those companies were founded. The most notable growth categories among the Inc. 5000 fastest growing businesses are in the Energy category (which grew by 298%) followed by Government Services (which grew by 220%), Security(200% growth) IT Services and Software (both grew by 187%).

The 2008 Inc. 5000 list measures revenue growth from 2004 through 2007. To qualify, companies must be U.S. based and privately held, independent of other companies and have had at least \$200,000 in revenue in 2004 and \$2 million in 2007.
