equipment can contain materials that are both valuable and hazardous to our environment, our de-manufacturing partners guarantee all equipment is processed into recyclable components while hazardous materials are properly disposed of.

Steel, aluminum and other precious metals are harvested for re-use. And, Certificates of Destruction are issued assuring that disposed products do not re-enter the marketplace.

Both of our de-manufacturing partners also provide secure data management services. **Disk drives are completely shredded, thus destroying sensitive data and protecting customer confidentiality.**

Financially:
